GENERAL USE

Follow these steps to get the most out of your cooler season after season.

LOOK IT OVER

Before you put your Roadie® Cooler to good use, see that the gasket, hinges, wheels, and latches are unobstructed. Give it a good visual inspection all around.

KEEP IT CLEAN

After use and as needed, clean your cooler with a rag and mixture of mild soap and warm water. Make sure to clean areas prone to debris, like the gasket, wheels, and latches. A scrubbing brush helps with tougher stains or use a high-pressure sprayer. Store your cooler completely dry and closed.

PERFORMANCE

Follow these steps to get the most out of your cooler season after season.

1. PRE-CHILL COOLER AND CONTENTS

This is the no-brainer that's easy to forget. A warm cooler will melt your ice before it keeps anything chilled. Sacrifice a bag of ice to do the job of cooling it down and pour it all out once it feels cool to the touch on all interior sides. Then load it up: all contents should be pre-chilled. For even better performance, food and water may be frozen.

2. USE THE RIGHT AMOUNT OF ICE

We advise the contents of the cooler are: 2/3 ice, 1/3 food and drink. For example, 18 cans of your favorite 12 oz. beverage should be accompanied by about 16 lbs. of ice. There's a lot more to learn about ice. Check out yeti.com/roadieicerecommendation for the full education.

3. ACCESSORIES

The #1 recommended Roadie accessory is YETI ICE® - it's packed with science and capable of bringing down the temperature of regular ice, making it last even longer. Check out all accessories at yeti.com/accessories.

4. KEEP YOUR ROADIE CLOSED

Consider air to be the enemy here. Never leave the cooler open when not in use. Get in. Get your goods. Get out. Reduce any airspace within the cooler by using towels or a foam mat if you don't have more ice.
